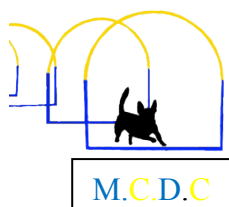

NFC runs available

A handler may choose to run NFC in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has the standard course time to train in the ring.

Training Treats/small individual treats may NOT be taken into the ring.

Class Descriptions

Hoops – A course made purely of Hoops.

Mixed Lot – A course consisting of Hoops, Barrels and possibly Tunnels.

Tunnels – A course consisting of mostly tunnels but may use some hoops and/or barrels.

Barrels – A course consisting of mostly Barrels with a Hoop to start and finish.

Dog Height/s

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15 cm or less

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more

There will be measuring available on the day.

Level Classification

Starters – All NEW dogs start here.

Improvers

Class C

Class B

Class A

Veteran – Available for dogs over the age of 9 yrs.

Progression

Each of the class types will have a separate progression system. There by allowing a dog to become a Class A in Hoops without ever having to compete in a class containing contacts. Points earned in one type of class will only count towards progression of that class type, eg Points earned in Hoops classes won't count towards progression in Mixed Lot.

Awards

Placement rosettes will be awarded to approx 20% of pre-entered numbers. Trophies/Prizes will be awarded to all winners and then based on class numbers. Trophies/Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- ✓ Less than 20 dogs in class – 1st
- ✓ 21 to 40 dogs in class – 1st - 2nd
- ✓ 41 to 60 dogs in class – 1st -3rd
- ✓ 61 to 80 dogs in class – 1st -4th
- ✓ 81 to 100 dogs in class –1st - 5th

Special Classes – 1st and 2nd place trophies and 1st – 4th place rosettes for all clear rounds.

It is the owner/handlers responsibility to ensure both their dog and themselves are fit and able to compete, the organisers will accept no responsibility for injury to dogs or their handlers whilst at the show. Children are the responsibility of their parents.

All dogs are to be kept on lead, unless in the designated exercise area or competing in the rings.

We would like to keep this venue so please respect it and clean up after your dog and yourselves.

Camping is available by booking with Cornwall Agility Club – please see their schedule for the agility show for information.

If you are entering dogs for both agility and Hoopers please use separate forms and Agility runs will take priority on the day, Hoopers classes will wait for you.
